The HMIS2030 online platform

The National Higher Education Mobility and Internationalisation Strategy 2020–2030 (HMIS2030) aims to promote the internationalisation of higher education institutions. The strategy, which was developed in a participatory process strategy, comprises five goals:

- Promoting a comprehensive culture of internationalisation at higher education institutions
- Promoting mobility for all higher education institution staff
- Development and realisation of innovative digital mobility formats
- Effective competence development and institutional learning
- Global Mindset Austria's higher education institutions in the world

All goals are subdivided into implementation goals - the online portal offers the Austrian higher education institutions the possibility to manifest the lived practice around the HMIS2030.
